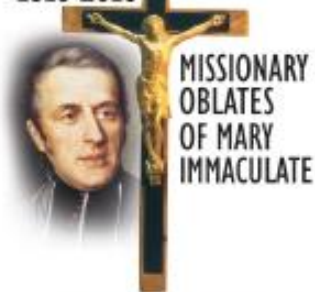

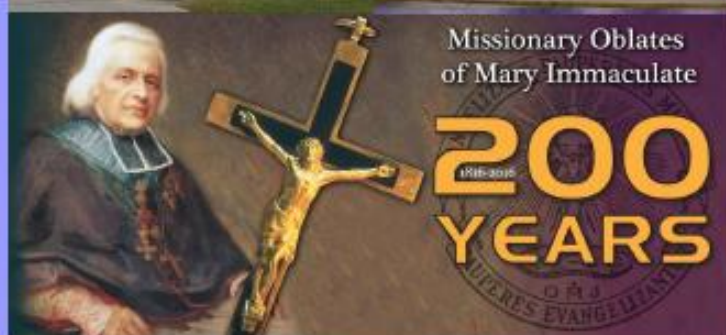
June 23-26, 2016
